

Generations of Grace:

The following lesson was taught in children's church this Sunday, **May 12, 2024**

MESSAGE: The Church is persecuted and the gospel spreads

PASSAGE: Acts 8:1-25

PRINCIPLE: There is one gospel for all kinds of people.

ASK YOUR CHILD: Who was the fiercest persecutor of the Jerusalem church? Where did Philip preach the gospel? Why was this unusual? Why did the Samaritans not receive the Holy Spirit when they believed? What was Simon's belief like? Why did Simon want the Holy Spirit? What did Simon think about his sin? What is the main problem in a fake believer?

APPLY: How is "the blood of the martyrs" the "seed of the church"? How good is the news of Jesus to you? What have you had to give up to have Jesus? Why must our gospel proclamations be accompanied by genuine love? Are you willing to talk about Jesus to people you are not comfortable around? Is it ok to change the gospel to make it more acceptable to different people or cultures? Why or why not?

信息：教會遭受迫害，福音被廣傳

經文：使徒行傳 8:1-25

信念：不論什麼人種，只有一個福音

向你子女問：誰是耶路撒冷教會最兇惡的迫害者？腓利在哪裡傳福音？為什麼這不尋常？為什麼撒瑪利亞人相信時沒有接受聖靈？西門的信仰是怎麼樣的？西門為什麼想要聖靈？西門對他的罪有什麼看法？假信徒的主要問題是什麼？

應用：「殉道者的血」如何成為「教會的種子」？耶穌的消息對你來說有多好？為了擁有耶穌，你必須放棄什麼？為什麼我們傳福音時必須要有真誠的愛？你願意向那些讓你感到不自在的人談論耶穌嗎？我們可不可以改變福音以使其更容易被不同的人或文化接受？為什麼以及為什麼不呢？
