Generations of Grace:

The following lesson was taught in children's church this Sunday, June 16, 2024

MESSAGE: The Gentiles are saved by faith alone

PASSAGE: Acts 15:1-35

PRINCIPLE: Salvation is by grace alone.

ASK YOUR CHILD: Why did some Jews say Gentiles needed to be circumcised to be saved? Who argued against them in Antioch and then in Jerusalem? What example did Peter give to prove them wrong? How do you know Cornelius was saved? What did James say about Gentiles being saved? What prophet did James say predicted Gentiles being saved? Why did James tell Gentile Christian to avoid immorality and certain foods? What was the result of the council?

APPLY: How does Paul describe false teachers? Are Christians saved by good works or saved in order to do good works? When you do good things, why do you do them? What kind of evidence did Peter, Barnabas, Paul and James use to prove that Gentiles are saved by grace alone? Can you be justified by doing the works required by the law? Just because something is not a sin, does that mean you should do it? List some things you sometimes have to give up, not because they are wrong, but in order to be kind to others (giving up your plan for the day, the toys you want to play with, etc.).

信息: 外邦人因信得救

經文: 使徒行傳 15:1-35

信念: 救贖唯獨靠著恩典

向你子女問:為什麼有些猶太人說外邦人需要受割禮才能得救? 誰在安提阿和耶路撒冷反對他們? 彼得舉了什麼例子來證明他們錯了? 你怎麼知道哥尼流得救了? 關於外邦人得救,雅各怎麼說? 雅各說哪一位先知預言外邦人會得救? 為什麼雅各告訴外邦人的基督徒要避免不道德的行為和避免某些食物? 公會的結果是什麼?

應用:保羅如何描述假教師? 基督徒是因善行得救,還是得救之後可以行善? 當你做好事時,為什麼要做這些好事? 彼得、巴拿巴、保羅和雅各用什麼證據來證明外邦人唯獨靠恩典得救? 依照律法行事,你能稱義嗎? 某件事不是罪,就代表你應該做這事嗎? 列出一些你有時必須放棄的事情,不是因為它們是錯的,而是為了善待他人 (放棄你某天的計畫、放棄你想玩的玩具等)。
